

A Note on Encampments: Diocesan policy requires that any “third party” user of property or buildings carry liability insurance independent of the church’s insurance. Thus, permitting a temporary encampment is possible – pursuant to municipal regulations about such encampments but liability insurance must be proven before permitting such a use. Most encampments run 90 days with, in some cases, one extension. Typically, the encampment will need access to potable water and electricity. Portable toilets are typically provided by the encampment organizers.
