Convention Resolutions with Actions

Resolution 1 – 2024 Diocesan Assessment Rate (adopted as submitted)

Sets the 2024 diocesan assessment rate factor at 14.5% of the Net Disposable Income (NDI).

Resolution 2 – Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) to Clergy Salary Scale for 2023 (adopted as amended)

Sets the cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) for 2023 parochial clergy salary scale and Office of the Bishop staff salary scale at 8.7%. 2023 Parochial Clergy Salary Scale is available on the diocesan website.

Resolution 3 – Establishing Minimum Clergy Compensation Regarding Compensation for Deacons (adopted as submitted)

Established a policy that provides deacon(s) and non-stipendiary priest(s) – who are currently serving in parishes on a regularly scheduled basis for a minimum of five consecutive months or more, who currently have a Letter of Agreement on file with the Bishop's office, and who are under the age of 72 – with a minimum of \$25 per month as remuneration, along with the required contribution of 18% (\$4.50 monthly) to the Church Pension Fund.

Resolution 4 – Creation Justice Pledge (adopted as submitted)

Recommends the study, reflection, and education in congregations about the Creation Justice Pledge and encourages congregants and congregations to study the pledge, adapt it to their local context, and adopt it. Requests the Diocese of Olympia to provide a web page for those adopting the pledge which would provide resources for assisting in determining their personal and congregational carbon footprint.

Resolution #5: Considering Adoption of a Season of Creation (adopted as submitted)

Asks the diocese to consider adoption of a Season of Creation, with incorporate of the five-week season into the diocesan calendar for promotion and education in our diocese. Commends to and encourages all congregations in our diocese to study and creatively adapt the Season of Creation to celebrate and better understand Creation in their locality

Resolution #6: Increasing the financial support and commitment for the BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color) Ministry Fund ("BMF.") (referred to the Diocesan Council)

Requests an increase in the funding specifically designated for just compensation of BIPOC leaders of primarily ethnic, multicultural, and multilingual congregations from 2% to 5% of the Diocesan operating budget, effective 2024. Asks that, in the event that primary liturgical, pastoral and administrative leadership of an ethnic/BIPOC parish, mission, or designated mission station is carried out by a designated Lay Pastoral Leader, that such leader be eligible for funding from the BMF.
