## CATEGORY DEFINITIONS FOR NON-PAROCHIAL CLERGY

### Non-Parochial

- In Church-related employment
- In Secular employment
- Retired
- Other

Some examples:

**Non-parochial, in Church-related employment:** An ordained person who works full time on the diocesan staff or in a specialized ministry, who also supplies regularly in a parish on weekends. This person would be non-parochial unless more than half of his/her ministry were in a parish environment.

**Non-parochial, in Secular employment:** An ordained person who works full time at a secular position and who may supply at a variety of parishes on weekends.

**Retired:** If the Church Pension Fund has you on their records as “retired” you are considered retired for the purpose of this report, even if you are currently serving in a congregation.

**Other:** Monastics, students, teachers, and those canonically resident in the Diocese of Olympia, but working elsewhere (even in a mission or parish), are “non-parochial” for the purpose of this report.
